Athanase Pentogenis, 74 of Monroe Township, New Jersey passed away on Saturday, July 10, 2021, at the Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital in New Brunswick, New Jersey, he was surrounded by the love of his family.

Born Wednesday, November 20, 1946 in the town of Mitilini, on the island of Lesvos, in Greece, Athanase was the son of the late Peter and Merope Pentogenis.

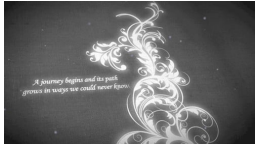
