



Adam P. Bartkowech Jr.

November 20, 1924 - October 9, 2011

Adam Paul Bartkowech, Jr., 87, passed away October 9 of natural causes in Old Bridge, NJ. He was born in Jersey City, NJ to Adam Bartkowech (born in Warsaw, Poland) and Theresa Bartkowech (maiden Stoder, born in Czechoslovakia). Adam served in the U.S. Navy with the 106th and 131st Battalions (Seabees) from 1943 to 1946, when he received an Honorable Discharge. He graduated from Decker Flying School (New Brunswick, NJ) in 1947 and received his High School Equivalent Certificate from The State of New Jersey in 1965. After working as a machinist with various companies in the New Brunswick area, he attained Machinist 1st Class and then became an accomplished Tool and Die Maker, further developing his trade with Allied Tool & Die, Cornell Dubilier, Okonite Cables, RCA, Lockheed Electronics, and Johnson & Johnson. His son and daughter recall their father's love of fishing and crabbing off Belmar and Sandy Hook. "I still remember the lights going on at 4:30 am," said Raymond. "He'd shake my shoulder gently and whisper, 'Raymond... time to go fishin!'" He is survived by his daughter, Theresa L. Swaynie and grand-daughter Elizabeth Ann Swaynie of Williamston, MI, his son, Raymond A. Bartkowech of Woburn, MA, and his former wife Anne Bartkowech Brooks of North Brunswick, NJ.
