Angelina Correnti, 81 of Manalapan, New Jersey passed away on Saturday, May 14, 2022, at the Roosevelt Care Center in Old Bridge.

Born Monday, February 3, 1941 in Brooklyn, New York, Angelina was one of two children born to the late Dominick and Mary Totillo.

Angelina was raised in the Bay Ridge section of Brooklyn, and was a graduate of Bay Ridge High School. 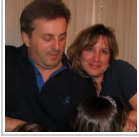

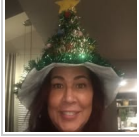
