From Mamma Anna on March 28, 2021 (her comments regarding the pandemic):

This pandemic is difficult, but we have to make the best of it.

In the war (WW II), the English were shooting at us (in Italy). The Americans were bombing us while we were walking. I literally walked with my mother while the Americans were bombing us and people were dying.

We were alive by a miracle. Having fled our home in Naples, we took refuge in a farmhouse.

The US was coming to the town of Avellino to bomb us daily. I guess because the German military was there.

So, that was frightening in a different way than now.

The building where I was staying temporarily as a safe haven, was bombed and the lady that

actually lived there and rented us a room, died. We would have as well, if our crucifix on the table did not spontaneously break in two. My mother (Nonnina Maria) thought it was a sign since the Americans sent flyers out alerting that they would bomb us. That was terrifying.

We were saved by a miracle and survived. And now, we will survive this crisis.

Anna Fuzzi...my mother...where to begin to describe her?! She was a force of pure energy and effervescence. She lit up any room she entered and any life she touched. I will share a story because it tells so much.

A few years back, I was in Florida. I was walking into a Barnes & Noble. There was a courtyard and a large group of Italian senior citizens seated engaging in lively conversation (Italian style). I went into the store and when I came out, the group had dwindled down. A kind-faced gentleman came up to me and in Italian said to me, "You're Neapolitan, aren't you?" I was a bit stunned because my mother was indeed from Naples. I asked him how he knew this. He said it was my eyes. He said they were Neapolitan eyes and then he said that he actually had only seen eyes like that once before...the eyes of a Neapolitan prima ballerina named Anna and I, then, interrupted him and asked, "Abbona?" He looked at me stunned and asked me how I knew her name? Did I follow the world of ballet? I told him that she was my mother. His eyes filled with tears of joy! He went on to tell me that he was her greatest fan. He followed her performance schedule and traveled near and far to see her beauty and grace float angelically center stage. He said that when she danced, she was not performing - she was at one with the dance, the music,

the character and most of all the audience. He said when she graced the stage, she touched each and every soul like no other ever could. He went on to tell me that he had tried with all his might to meet her backstage, always with roses in hand for her. He was never permitted entrance. It was his life long regret to not have met her. He then looked to me with a flash of worry.... he started to ask, "Is she...." I interjected... alive and well and still dancing....ever graceful. Again, tears of joy in his eyes. I understood that this kind man was truly touched by my mom in a profound way.... even felt some form of love and deep admiration. She was not just dancing on stage she was emitting her abundant energy and gracious heart.

I then asked him if he wanted to speak with her. He was so taken with gratitude - he said it would make his life long dream come true. I called mom and explained the situation as best I could - of course, after a barrage of questions because she feared he may be a con artist or maybe worse. Once I got the whole story out (as the man had named people, places and performances which led her to believe him), she agreed to speak with him. I gave him my phone and walked away to let them have this incredible moment. He called it a miracle and that it was....most obviously to me now because it has led to my telling of this wonderful story. They only spoke that one time. He and I have emailed over the years. And once in a while, my mom would ask me if I had heard from " my friend." I knew who she meant.

I share this story here today, for so many reasons. It shows how remarkable her beauty and grace have always been. It shows that even in her youth, she was an angel among us. It shows her empathy and ability to connect with people even with just her gaze. It shows how she could tell a story even with a simple gesture. But most of all, it shows how absolutely unforgettable she is!

The only way to describe my mother is a true force of nature! Vibrant, passionate, artistic, eloquent, genuine.... she told it as it was - good or bad! Generous - with her heart and, most definitely with food - kind, hospitable,

immensely creative, youthful, charming, elegant, glamorous (I always called her my glam doll mom), intuitive to an awe-inspiring level, intelligent and, above all else, dedicated and devoted to any cause she took on and to all those she cared about.

My mother was truly avant-Garde...a woman ahead of her time, likely ahead of all our times. She had boundless energy and endless ideas - all original, all her own. She was the epitome of true fortitude and joie de vivre!

She led a full and interesting life. Each new chapter quite different from the one before it. She was born in Naples, Italy. She was fluent in several languages and was even certified to teach German, a language she loved! She was an extraordinary dancer with a graceful and natural talent. From a very young age, she was the premier prima ballerina of the European Ballet world. She was also certified to teach classical ballet from the young age of 12. She told me that often when her students first saw her, they would ask, "what can this little girl teach us?" Pioneer that she was, she then, with a silent nod, told the maestro to play Tchaikovsky and then she showed them just what that little girl could teach them! They never asked again!

She embraced her European career in ballet with great passion and dedication, even living in, among other places, France, Germany and Switzerland. She had attended Swiss schools, as well.

In her next intriguing chapter, she declined opportunities to embark on an acting career, as she chose to study law in Italy, following in the footsteps of her father, who was a renowned criminal attorney and an esteemed political figure. This was, again, proof of her determination as indeed a pioneer.... as in that time period, a woman studying the law was truly unheard of. That did not stop her. Perhaps it served to motivate her! She set her sights on it and completed her studies. She was already fluent in English and proceeded to work with immigration issues at the American consulate. And so began her love for America!

She first journeyed to Florida. She enjoyed her time there immensely, making friends immediately. She felt quite at home. She, then visited New York City

and loved it! Adventurer that she was, she moved there. Quite remarkable for a single woman in that era. Again, likely a source of inspiration for her.

She worked with a patent attorney firm on Columbus Circle in Manhattan. Our family destiny was sealed there. Mom's colleague, Norma, invited her to a dinner party. Norma's husband, Ronaldo, invited his friend and colleague, a young, Italian engineer named William Joseph Fuzzi to that same dinner party. As they say, the rest was history! It was love at first sight for Anna and Bill!

They married and Norma and Ronaldo later became my godparents!

Life in New York was a happy time. My mom was involved in so many charitable works! She was involved with several women's groups and various Italian American organizations! She also worked closely with churches of various denominations and synagogues, as well. She was also affiliated with an Italian American television station. She also taught Italian and dance. She worked as a social director at an Italian resort. Her personal social calendar was full, as well. She and my dad belonged to the Men's and Women's clubs of Forest Hills. She not only attended all their many varied functions, but she organized them all! There were luncheons, fashion shows, afternoon tea events and above all else dinner dances, where she and my dad were the main attraction with their stunning ballroom dancing. Mom was absolutely the belle of each and every ball.

Even with all this going on in her life, she was very involved in my school. My parents sent me to private, Catholic school. Everyone there knew her... the teachers, the kids and the other parents! My classmates would shout with glee, " your mom is here!" They knew we'd have fun and good treats! She even saved one boy's life. He was choking and she saved him before anyone else even noticed! That was my mom....perceptive, seeing what no one else saw and was fast acting!

Our house was always full. My mom loved to entertain, inviting friends and family for lavish Italian meals that she and my grandmother prepared together. Music playing, my dad would sing and ultimately dancing would ensue. My friends were a permanent presence in our house. To many of them, my mom

was a second mom to them! They loved to come over. We always had a kitchen full of the best snacks and then dinners that my friends still remember to this day.

New Jersey was the next chapter. We found Foxborough Village by chance on our way to see another development. Mom always followed her intuitions and Foxborough Village instantly became our home in 1986. The first thing mom did, as was her way, was to become involved in the community. She became a member of the Homeowner's Association Board and fought and won many a battle for the good of the community she loved so much! She also created and chaired the Recreational and Social Events Committee. Over the years (starting in 1986), she single handedly organized and ran summer barbecues, spring brunch events, dance and exercise classes, luncheons, fashion shows, holiday parties, a children's program that included weekly arts and crafts classes over the summer, as well as kiddie bingo, pizza and ice cream parties and even field trips to places like FunMania and Chuck E. Cheese and let us not forget Anna Fuzzi's infamous and wonderful annual Halloween party!! Anna sure knew how to throw a party and get everyone out on the dance floor!! I must share, that as her assistant for these endeavors, she was so dedicated to the children and families of Foxborough Village that she would spend hours during her summer nights creating and meticulously preparing the craft projects for the children. She did not buy ready made kits. She made them one by one by hand. And when she prepared loot bags, she counted each piece of candy because she wanted to make sure each child received the same amount! She was amazing!! Pure love in her heart! She knew every child's name and became friends with many of the parents. And every child always received a gift to go home with. The greatest thank you for her dedication was from the kids themselves! They returned year after year! They loved Anna! In fact, there were some who came even after college just because they loved my mom and her program was an important part of their childhoods! An even more amazing tribute to my mom was when those who

had attended when they were kids then, in later years, brought their own children! What an honor for my mom! She loved our Foxborough Village community and its families and children! This showed via her good works! Mom was also involved in an Italian American club here, in NJ. As was her way, she organized many fund raising functions (such as fashion shows, luncheons, auctions and dinner dances) for scholarships for college-bound Italian American students. Thanks to her efforts, over the years, many a student received assistance toward tuition.

The most amazing thing is that while my mom did all these incredible things, she was simultaneously fully dedicated to me, my dad and my three children! They all refer to my mother as “mamma” because she was, in fact, another mother to them!! And she was definitely the one that cooked!! Thanks to my mother and father (and my grandmother, Nonnina as we called her), I was able to pursue my studies and then work in my field because the kids were in the safety of their care! And as her home was open to all my friends, the same applied for my kids. She was Mamma Anna to all!

My mom was proud of my accomplishments, often introducing me to people as “my daughter, the doctor.” It meant so much to her! I was so blessed to have had her here with me for so long. We did everything together. I assisted in all her activities. She guided me on all my endeavors - both personal and professional. She even dubbed me the DancingDoc! We dined out together, went for walks, exercised and danced together, we traveled extensively and let’s not forget shopping! My mom did love shopping! She was always dressed impeccably no matter where she went. Her hair and nails were always perfect! Pure elegant glamour!

My children were the greatest loves of her life! She was so happy that they called her “mamma.” That meant the world to her!

Recently, another immense joy took place, the arrival of her very precious great-grandson! She was so happy about his birth. I know that she, along with Grandpa Bill and Nonnina Maria will be watching over him.

In fact, my kids and I and, truly, any one who knew her, now have an ever-

protecting guardian angel.

My mother was the most intuitive person I have ever encountered. The things she could perceive and even predict were uncanny! She was an endless source of energy and effervescence. That powerful, magnificent, soulful, radiant light and energy that she boundlessly emitted is not gone. In that way, she will remain with us always. She once told me, that even when she was gone, every time I dance, she will be right there by my side. She and I always danced together. We even taught classes together. Billie Jean by Michael Jackson was her favorite dance song. We'd put it on a loop and dance for hours. I'd give anything for one more dance, Mom!

In all, my dear mother's life was indeed a life well-lived! She saw many changes in the world (at one event - she looked at my with big, bright eyes and said, " I feel like I am watching history being made." And she was correct.). She had many interesting chapters to her long life. She did extraordinary things and simple things and enjoyed them with the same vigor and joy! She was unstoppable! Determined! Loving! And absolutely the strongest person I know! The outpouring of wonderful messages all showing appreciation and admiration for my mom are the greatest honor for her, my family and for me. It will be very difficult for me without her here. She and I were like the Dynamic Duo.... I will have to, in time, figure out what Robin would do without Batman. I pray that mom will guide me from above, as she did in life. I will do my best to follow in her footsteps as a grandmother. And I shall dance everyday to feel her presence.

THANK YOU, MOM!!

I must take a moment to say thank you to my mother. Mom, thank you for being my mother and friend. Thank you for the many precious and priceless gifts that you have given to me over the years.... the gifts of love and care....the gift of loving and learning other languages....my fluency in and passion for the Italian language came from you and opened the doorway to other languages....for the gift of the love of studying....for the gifts of music and dance which always united us and, later in life, that lifestyle of movement

and fitness saved my life when crisis arose.....the gift of your intensely prayerful soul that saw me through good times and bad and, in three particular situations, literally saved my life.... the gift of your hospitality and wonderful food....the gift of including me in all of your good works and participating in and guiding me through all of my endeavors, always improving them with your keen mind and creative thinking....I could go on, but suffice it to say thank you for being beautiful, magnificent YOU!! A wonderful wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother and friend and “Mamma” to all. I love you forever, mom! Ti voglio bene per sempre, mamma!

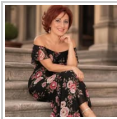

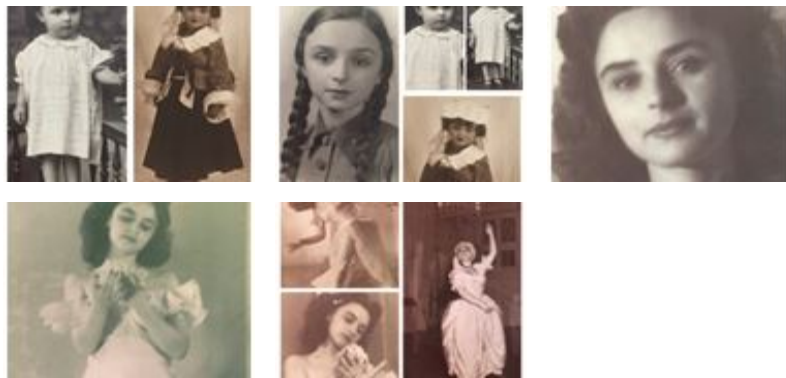
