Annie J. Corrigan, age 75, of Old Bridge, died Wednesday, May 19, 2010 at Raritan Bay Medical Center in Old Bridge. Born in Ferefad, Longford, Ireland, she lived in Jersey City, before moving to Old Bridge 45 years ago. Mrs. Corrigan attended primary and secondary schools in Ireland, and had earned her Associate Degree in Nursing from Middlesex County College. She was a Registered Nurse for 32 years, employed by South Amboy Hospital, the Visiting Nurses of NJ, and Monmouth Medical Center. She was a member of St. Ambrose RC Church, Old Bridge, where she was a CCD teacher for 25 years, a member of their Senior Group, the Altar Rosary Society, St. Vincent De Paul Society and their Bereavement Group. She was also a member of the Pioneer Total Abstinence Society, New York. Mrs. Corrigan was predeceased by her parents, Richard & Evelyn Gorman, her brother Richard Gorman, and her sister, Nora Leahy.
