November 21, 1949 - November 22, 2025

On November 22, 2025, the day after Barry's 76th birthday, he earned his wings and was called home to rest. Barry was affectionately known by his mother as 'Butch.' He was born on November 21, 1949, in Lincoln Hospital in the Bronx to Bertha 'Bird' Way-Bradley and Leonard Bradley. He was Billy's younger brother, whom he loved dearly and looked up to throughout his life. He was born into a loving home, surrounded by warmth, care, and the deep family values that shaped him into the man he became.

Barry attended St. Anne Catholic Elementary School, Paul Laurence Dunbar Middle School, and P.S. 176 High School in the Bronx, NY, where he formed early friendships and where his sense of humor first shone. Barry loved riding his bike; the funny part was Barry could never get it back upstairs - no matter how many times he rode it, bringing it home was always a challenge he just couldn't conquer.

During his early adult years, Barry became a father to his beloved son, Barsheen Bradley Isaac, who held a special place in his heart. He often shared memories with warmth and pride, and even after his son's passing, Barry carried that love with him throughout his life. He dedicated many years of his life to helping others. He worked as a Drug Counselor/House Manager at Samaritan Village in Queens, where he supported individuals battling addiction, offering guidance, understanding, and hope. His comforting

presence touched countless lives, and he was committed to giving the same compassion and love to others that he had been given from birth.

Barry was raised in faith and grounded in his knowledge of Jesus from a young age.

His family instilled in him a love of prayer, strength through faith, and a trust in God in all things. Barry grew up watching his family lean on the Lord through joys and hardships, and that spiritual foundation stayed with him throughout his life.

Barry adored his mother and spoke lovingly of her throughout his life. He took great joy in sharing stories of her love and a no-nonsense demeanor, even up until his final days. He often talked about the closeness between his mother and her siblings - a bond filled with laughter, affection, and genuine love. They raised their children on the unshakeable principle: family is first, and Barry carried those values proudly throughout his life.

Barry leaves behind his granddaughter, Zeldaijah Shaquan Isaac, and three first cousins: Janette Bradley, Joanne Ulmer, and Martha Bradley, whom he adored and loved as his sisters, along with a host of other cousins, loved ones, and friends who cherished him deeply.

Although the days ahead may feel heavy for those who love and adore Barry, please know we take comfort in knowing he is reunited with his mother, Bertha, his father, Father Leonard, his son, Barsheen, his brother, Billy, and all the loved ones who welcomed him into Heaven. We rest in the assurance that Barry is now whole, free from pain, and at peace in the presence of the Lord.

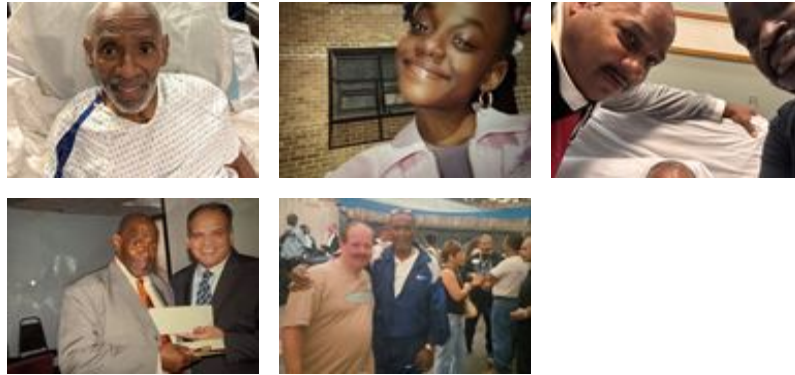
