Brian Martin Burke, 62 of Howell, New Jersey died on Sunday, May 28, 2017, at Jersey Shore University Medical Center in Neptune, New Jersey.

Born Tuesday, April 5, 1955 in Perth Amboy, New Jersey, Brian was the son of the late John Harold and Helen Burke.

Raised in Edison Brian graduated from JP Stevens High School and Middlesex County College. Brian would marry his wife Dawn (Kontos) and they would move to Howell where they have resided for the past 30 years. Brian was active in the Boy Scouts, serving as webmaster for Troop 150, he would see his Sean through to Eagle Scout. Brian was also an active member of the Friendly Sons of the Shillelagh of Old Bridge, where he also served a stint as webmaster for a few years.
