



## Carmine Malanga

November 11, 1930 - November 5, 2022

Carmine 'Junior' Malanga, 91, passed away peacefully at the Venetian Care Center in South Amboy, NJ on November 5, 2022.

Born in Newark, NJ, Carmine attended Bloomfield Tech where he received his aeronautics license. Upon graduation, he was drafted into the then Army Air Corps.

During the Korean War, he was stationed in Germany as an aircraft mechanic where he met and married his wife Ginharda 'Ginny' Barfuss. Upon returning from the war, he attended Fairleigh Dickinson College and received a degree in Hotel Accounting to help run his family's hotel, the beautiful Montauk in Asbury Park.
