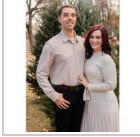

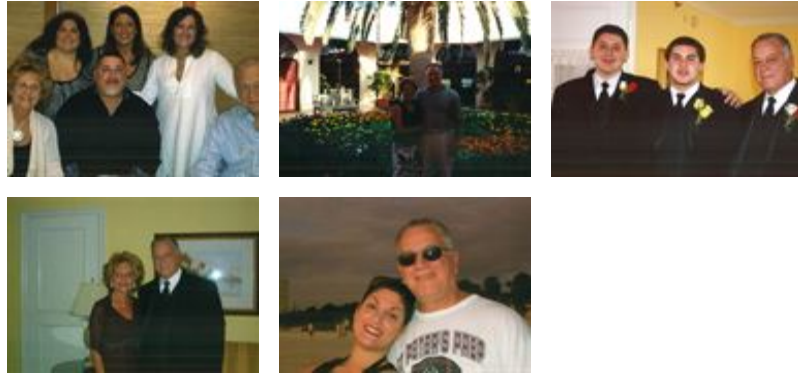

“ I met Carmine 6 or 7 years on the "bench" at the corner of Middlebury Lane and Old Nassau Road. He was sitting out there one evening with his Mom enjoying the cool breezes at the end of a hot day.....and the rest is history. When I met Carmine I was still walking and driving, so with similar interests we did many things together. Lunch at "Yogi's", hitting golf balls at the driving range, going to the movies, listening to old style rock and roll music..... whatever! My wife fell in love with him, my kids (all grown) fell in love with him as did much of my family and many of my friends and of course our dog Snowman.

We talked about almost everthing under the Sun. Family, politics (he hated politicians.....they were all SOB.S to him) and a lot of sports. Nothing was off limits. He even taught me about the importance of using the word 'whatever" as part of normal conversation. Just about every time he left my house he would shake my hand and kiss me on the cheek. He was a man's man.

AT THAT TIME BOTH OF OUR FATHERS WERE OFF FIGHTING A WAR{WWII} .DAHLGREEN PLACE NOT ONLY OUR RESIDENCE BUT WAS OUR PLAYGROUND. IN THE STREET WE PLAYED STICKBALL,STOOPBALL,SLAPBALL,ROLLERSKATE HOCKEY AND NUMEROUS OTHER GAMES.
