



## Carmine J. Vastola

January 2, 1920 - December 14, 2012

Carmine J. Vastola, 92, passed away Friday, December 14, 2012 at the New Jersey Veterans Memorial Home-Menlo Park, in Edison. Born in New York City, Carmine, known to his family as "Lefty", lived in the Lafayette Estates section of Fords, and the Covered Bridge section of Manalapan before moving to Edison. He was a Teamster driving for Roadway Express for 25 years, retiring in 1985. A member of the Freehold American Legion; a parishioner of St. Thomas More Church, Manalapan; serving in the US Navy from 1943 to 1957 in the Pacific Theater in WWII and the Korean War as a 2nd class radar man.
