Dieter M. Kuegler, 80, of Monroe Township died Wednesday, September 17, 2014 at home surrounded by his loving family. Born in Germany he came to the US in 1956 and settled in New York City. Dieter later moved to Bedminster where he resided for 47 years before moving to Monroe Township last year. Dieter was a Carpenter and worked with Epstein's in Morristown for over 30 years before retiring in 2004. He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Oldwick for many years.
