



## Dominick Franchini

June 22, 1944 - August 19, 2017

Dominick Franchini, 73 of Old Bridge, New Jersey died on Saturday, August 19, 2017, at home surrounded by his loving family.

Born Thursday, June 22, 1944 in Brooklyn, New York, Dominick was the son of the late Louis and Raffaella Franchini.

Growing up in Brooklyn Dominick would graduate from Lafayette High School. He would eventually go onto the New York Technical Institute and the RCA Institute. Dominick would go on a blind date arranged by his brother and it was on that date he would meet the love of his life, Linda Dovico. They would wed in 1971 and would be married for the next 46 years. In 1983 the family would move to Old Bridge and remained there to raise their family. Dominick was a Broadcast Technician working with CBS television in New York City. He also enjoyed learning about the faith, never missing an opportunity to further his knowledge. Dominick will be missed by all who were blessed to have had him in their lives.
