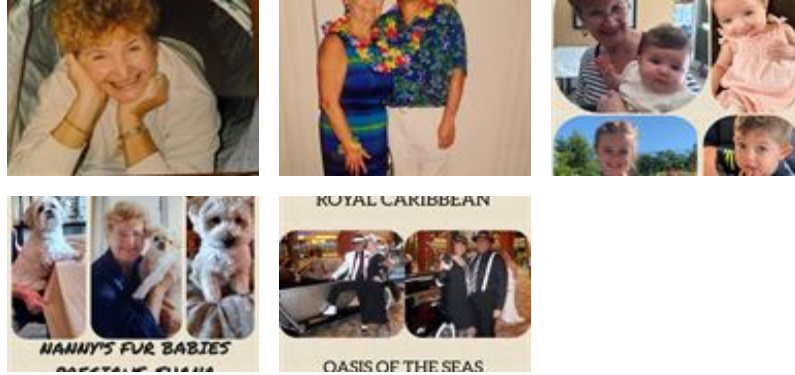

Myself, my husband John, and our family shall keep Dotty in out hearts forever.

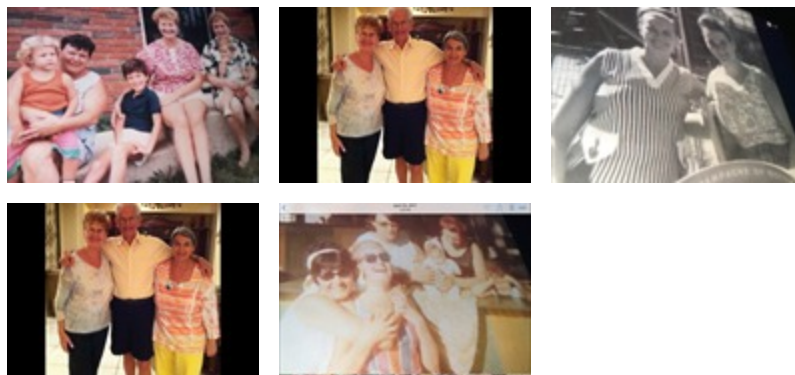
