



## Dorothy 'Dot' Schipani

April 5, 1966 - May 26, 2024

Dot Schipani passed away peacefully surrounded by her loving family on May 26, 2024, at Riverview Medical Center in Red Bank, New Jersey.

Born on April 5, 1966, Dorothy Mary Coyle was the youngest of five children born to Joan and Phil Coyle. Dot grew up in the Bay Terrace neighborhood of Staten Island, where she made lasting memories and lifelong friends.

She loved nothing more than spending time with her boys and was their biggest supporter. Dot was present at every cross country meet, as well as basketball and soccer games. She was an active member of the Cheesequake School PTA and served as a parent volunteer for the Old Bridge High School Cross Country Team.

Dot never let an opportunity pass to do something with Danny and the boys. This included watching the N.Y. Rangers and NASCAR races with her beloved dogs, Midnight, Dewey, and Kelly at her side.

Dot was the quintessential caretaker for so many people in her life, including family members, friends, and neighbors. Her compassion, caring nature, and sense of humor made her beloved by all who had the privilege to know her. Dot's door was always open and everyone was welcome. She loved hosting her

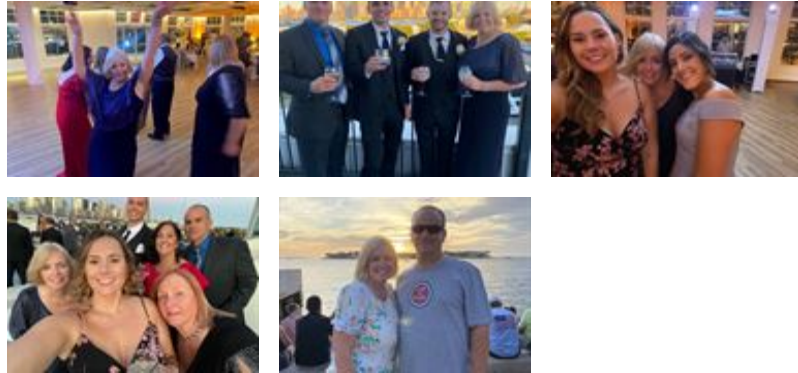
