Edna M. Petrosino, 86, of Old Bridge, New Jersey died on Monday, January 6, 2025, at Raritan Bay Medical Center in Perth Amboy, New Jersey.

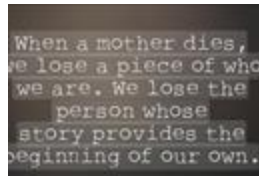

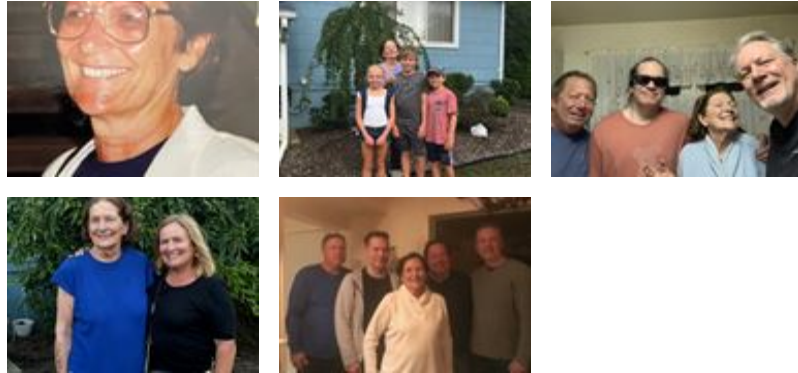

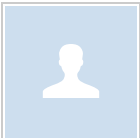
