Francis Michael Clark, 93 of Freehold, New Jersey passed away on Wednesday, September 20, 2023, at Mattison Crossing in Freehold.

Born Thursday, July 17, 1930 in Vailsburg, New Jersey, Francis was the son of the late Joseph and Frances Clark.

Francis grew up in Vailsburg, and was a graduate of Seton Hall Prep High School. He would go on to graduate from Seton Hall University. It was during this time he would meet the love of his life, Margaret (Peggy). The couple would marry and start a family of their own.

Francis was a member of the Army ROTC while attending Seton Hall University. After college he would enlist in the US Army Reserves. He volunteered 28 years of his life to his country, earning an Honorable Discharge, retiring as a Colonel. Francis worked for many years in the insurance industry as a Broker.

Francis and Peggy would soon settle in Old Bridge in 1959. They raised their children in Old Bridge and were active members of the community. Devout Catholics, Francis and Peggy would be instrumental in forming St. Ambrose Parish. Francis volunteered a lot of his time there, as a usher, member of the St. Vincent dePaul Society, serving on the bereavement group, and working

the church Bingo. Francis was also a member for the St. Thomas the Apostle Knights of Columbus.

When Francis wasn't volunteering his time he enjoyed golfing and traveling with Peggy. After retirement he looked forward to spending time with the family during their annual vacations to the Outer Banks of North Carolina where he treasured being surrounded by his loved ones. Francis was a caring and loving man who will be missed by all those that love him.

Francis was predeceased by his beloved wife, Peggy, and by his caring siblings, Mary Cain and George Clark.

Francis is survived by his loving children, Mark Clark and his wife Terry, and Denise Edgeworth and her husband Adam, by his caring sister Margaret Bundas, and by his cherished grandchildren, Ryan, Sean, Kevin (Shannon), Brenden, and Caleigh.

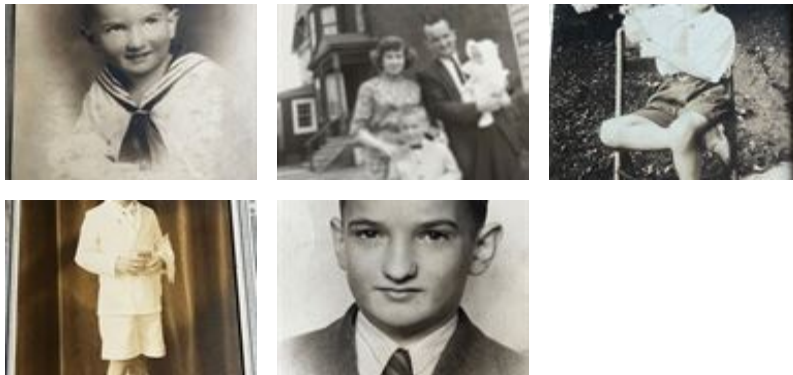
