Gabriel Rao, 84 of Matawan, New Jersey passed away on Friday, August 5, 2022, at the Raritan Bay Medical Center in Old Bridge.

Born Sunday, December 12, 1937 in Sicily, Italy, Gabriel was the son of the late Samuel and Giuseppa Rao.

Raised on the island of Sicily, Gabriel came to the United States in 1959. He would first live in Brooklyn. It was in Brooklyn, where Gabriel was working as a painter that he would meet the love of his life, Rosemarie Minutello. The couple would marry living first in Queens and Long Island, before returning to Brooklyn to start their family. They would begin to raise their sons in Brooklyn, before moving to Staten Island. They would live in Florida for a time, before settling in Matawan to be closer to family.

Gabriel worked for many years as a cement mason and was a member of the union. Gabriel also was the proprietor of Pizza D'Amore on Bay Parkway in Brooklyn. While living on Staten Island Gabriel enjoyed being a member of the Staten Island Bocce Club and was a Champion in the club multiple times. He loved gardening and spending time with his family.

Gabriel is survived by his beloved wife of 60 years Rosemarie, by his loving sons, Peter and his wife Claudia, and Paul and his wife Cherilyn, by his caring

siblings, Peter and Mimi, and by his cherished grandchildren, Paul, Gabriella, and Giancarlo.
