Giulio DiNozzi, 82 of Old Bridge, New Jersey died on Tuesday, September 5, 2017, at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital in New Brunswick, New Jersey.

Born Tuesday, July 23, 1935 in New York, New York, Giulio was the son of the late John and Antoinette DiNozzi.
