Gregory McKinney, 72 of Old Bridge, New Jersey went home to the Lord on Tuesday, July 16, 2024, at St. Peter's Hospital in New Brunswick.

Born Saturday, July 5, 1952 in Staten Island, New York, Gregory was the son of the late Leonard and Estelle McKinney.

Gregory was raised in the Stapleton neighborhood of Staten Island, he was an excellent student and athlete and after graduating from Curtis High school where he was senior class president, he went on to attend Michigan University. At Michigan University he played football and was a member of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity. Gregory earned a Bachelors Degree from Michigan and returned home to Staten Island.

Gregory first met Donna O'Loughlin in Elementary School PS 14. Greg knew from that point that he had found the love of his life.
