Ida E. Olano, 91 of Toms River, New Jersey went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, February 29, 2020, surrounded by the love of her family.

'Idalove', as she was known by those who knew her, was born in 1928 in Brooklyn, New York to the late Nicholas and Philomena Montemarano.

Special enough to enjoy two birthdays, Ida celebrated on both August 22nd, the date on her birth certificate, and August 27th, the day her mother swore she was born.

Ida grew up in the Bensonhurst section of Brooklyn, NY surrounded by her beloved siblings. 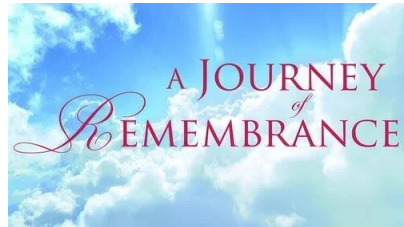

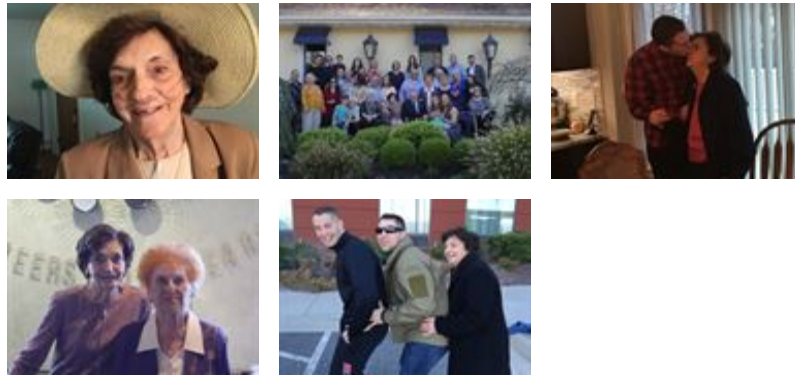
