



## John Corrigan

March 4, 1933 - July 5, 2022

John F. Corrigan of Old Bridge, passed away Tuesday, July 5, 2022, at home, at the age of 32,630 days (89 years). Born and raised in Jersey City to John and Elizabeth Corrigan, before moving to Old Bridge 57 years ago,

John attended Regis High School in NY, and earned his Bachelor's Degree from St. Peters University. Before serving in the Army, he began working at Exxon where he would later meet his wife, Annie, and continue his career as a Systems Analyst for 41 years. He was a member of St. Ambrose Roman Catholic Church, in Old Bridge, where he was a CCD teacher, a member of their Senior Group, and the treasurer of the St. Vincent De Paul Society. A lifelong baseball fan (Mets), John had visited all but 3 of the newest MLB Stadiums in the country and kept detailed records of his visits ranging from the quality of the hotdogs at the stadiums, to the level of accuracy at which Take Me Out to the Ballgame was sung. He also coached little league baseball and was an umpire for the Sayrewoods South Little League.

John was predeceased by his wife of 48 years, Annie Corrigan; his brothers, Thomas and Joseph Corrigan; his in-laws, Richard Gorman, Eva Coyle, Nora Leahy, Michael Bannon, Don Gettings, Maureen Corrigan, Sandra Corrigan, Angela Corrigan, and Hetty Corrigan; He is survived by his children, Eileen Ballance and wife Cathleen, Kevin Corrigan, Mary O'Connell and husband Steven, Patricia Corrigan, Sheila Zeman and husband Eric, and Brian

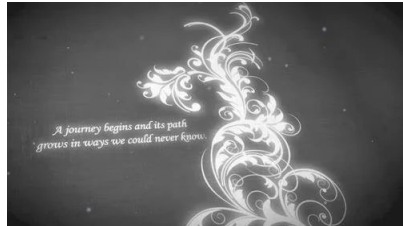

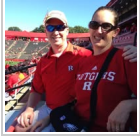
