So my sweet brother,

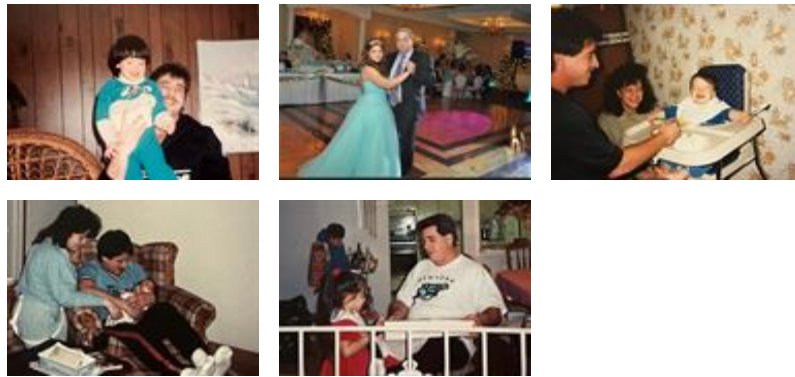
*Let those Golden slumbers fill your eyes and Take your broken
