Joseph also enjoyed coaching baseball and basketball for his son when he was younger. He loved taking trips to Atlantic City with his wife, and he was known for his smooth moves on the dance floor, often dancing with his wife to the timeless music of Frank Sinatra.

Joseph was a devoted family man, and above all, he cherished the time spent with his loved ones. He was a proud husband, father and grandfather, who never missed a school sporting event, family gathering, or celebration. He was happiest when surrounded by his wife, children, and grandchildren, creating lasting memories together.

Joseph had a gift for telling stories, and his anecdotes, filled with humor and wisdom, will live on in the hearts of those who knew him. He was a man of integrity, kindness, and unwavering dedication to his family and community.

Joseph is predeceased by his parents, Frank and Catherine, and his brothers, Frank and Bart.

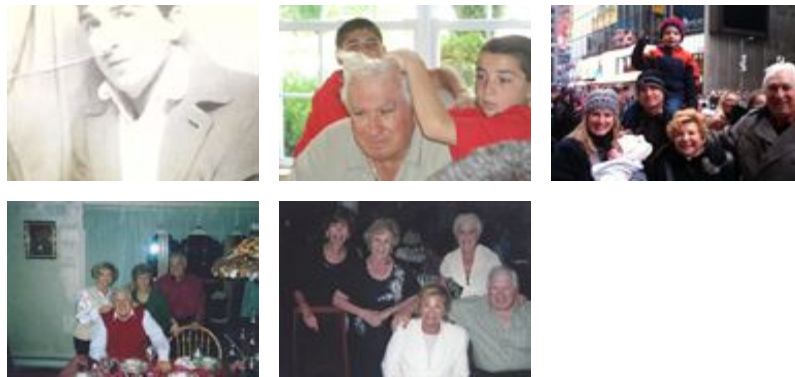
