Kevin Morgan, 79 of Parlin, New Jersey passed away on Friday, October 9, 2020, at the Venetian Care Center in South Amboy, New Jersey.

Kevin was raised in the Bronx, NY. He would go on to attend Iona Prep High School and then Iona College, where he played on the school's baseball team.
