Margaret 'Maggie' Guiro, 75 of Old Bridge, New Jersey passed away on Sunday, October 20, 2019, at the JFK Medical Center in Edison, New Jersey.

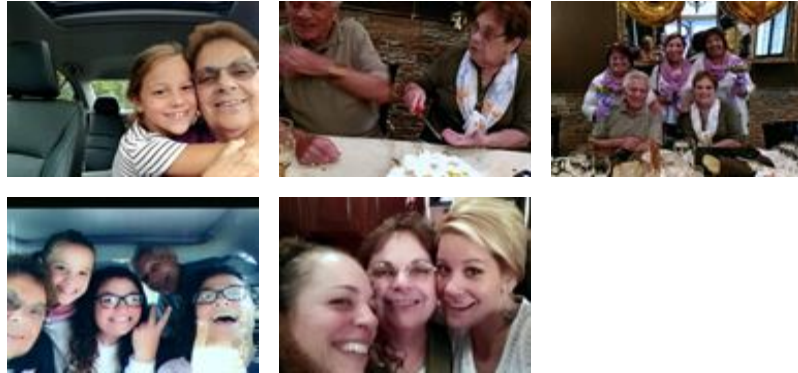

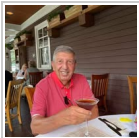
Maggie had an incredible memory for numbers, never forgot a birthday, cards always arrived on time loaded with confetti.
