Margaret Langlois, 79 of Old Bridge, New Jersey passed away on Wednesday, October 20, 2021, at the Raritan Bay Medical Center in Old Bridge.

Born Thursday, April 30, 1942 in Brooklyn, New York, Margaret was the daughter of the late Alfred and Margaret Rutherford.

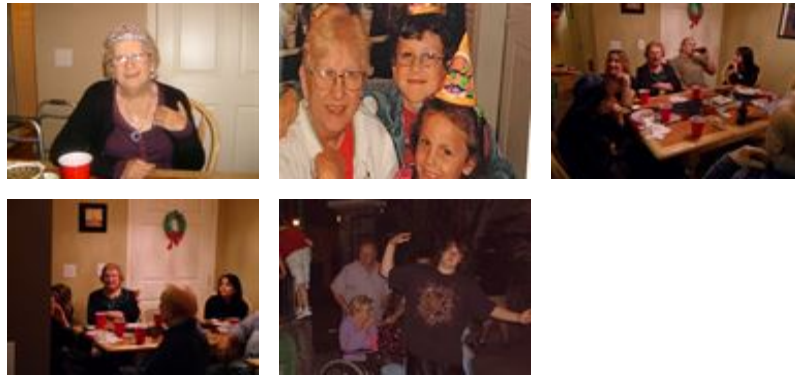
