Mary Virginia Garcia aged 66 has died. She was a resident of Old Bridge, NJ for 32 years. Mary Virginia Meares was born on 21 December 1942. She was one of three daughters of Virginia and Roy Meares. She attended Holy Cross School, and Clara Barton High School, Brooklyn where she graduated second in her class and received the Mayor's Award. She worked as a beautician and telephone operator.
