Mary B. McKeown nee Owens passed away on January 26, 2011 after a brief illness, at the age of 100 years. Born in Remackin, Sixmilecross, County Tyrone, Northern Ireland, she has resided in Old Bridge for more than 30 years, moving from Bronx, NY. Mrs. McKeown was a clerk for the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, Manhattan, for 27 years, retiring in 1975. She was an active member of St. Thomas the Apostle Legion of Mary; the St. Thomas Seniors; and the County Tyrone Society, and she had volunteered with the Interfaith Network Respite Program. Having entered eternal rest, she leaves fond memories of her strong faith, her love of family, friends, and all things Irish. Mary was predeceased by her husband, Gerald H., and her grandson, Michael Lynch. She was a Devoted Mother to Kevin and his wife, Mary; Geraldine Lynch and her husband, Frank; Eileen Hudock and her husband, Theodore.
