Mary Breslin Munoz of Matawan, NJ -- beloved mother, grandmother, sister, nurse, and friend -- passed away on Tuesday, July 20th, 2021, at age 69, after a battle with pancreatic cancer. In her final days, she was surrounded by family and friends.

Mary was born June 9, 1952 in Brooklyn, New York. She was the fifth of eight children of John and Patricia Breslin, both of whom she survived. She graduated from Catherine McAuley High School and then Hunter College, from which she graduated in 1975 with a nursing degree. She worked at Maimonides Hospital in New York City before moving to New Jersey in 1983 to raise her family as it grew to include five children. She worked at St. Peter's Hospital before moving to the Middlesex County Health Department. During her extensive career, she focused on patients who needed specialized care, including pregnant mothers with drug or alcohol addictions, sexual assault victims, and children with special needs.

More than anything else, she loved being around family. She enjoyed watching Jeopardy, going to the beach, taking family trips, and attending her grandchildren's sporting events. Mary is survived by her loving children, Felix and wife Lissette, Peter and wife Lisa, Matthew, Kathryn Kamen and husband Jack, and Marie Collins and husband Allen, by her cherished grandchildren, Felix, Eva, Audrey, Amelia, Azalea, and Talia, and by her caring siblings, Guy

Breslin and wife Marilyn, Peter Breslin and wife Susan, Ned Breslin and wife Sharon, Eleanor Breslin, Patricia Kessell and husband James, Robert Breslin and wife Kathleen, and James Breslin and wife Carol.
