Matthew Dominick Magliocco, 28 of Matawan, New Jersey passed away, suddenly, on Monday, January 11, 2021, at the Bayshore Community Hospital in Holmdel, New Jersey.

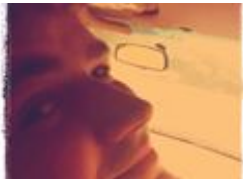
