In his later years, Michael cherished spending time with his wife, children, and grandchildren. He enjoyed visiting social clubs, making new friends, and playing cards at the Old Bridge Senior Center. He enjoyed his wine, gin martinis, and cigarettes, and was known as a knowledgeable, warm, and kind-hearted man. Michael would do anything for anyone without hesitation, which made him deeply admired and loved by all who knew him.

Above all, his family was his pride and joy. He never missed a special occasion and was always there for the people he loved. His presence, wisdom, and generous spirit will be missed dearly by all who had the privilege of knowing him.

Michael is survived by his beloved wife, Susanna Maiello; his sons Amedeo and his wife Carissa, Filippo and his wife Erika, and Michael and his wife Regina; and his treasured daughter Cinzia and her husband Joseph.
