Mickey McFarland, 66 of Old Bridge, New Jersey passed away on Saturday, November 19, 2022, at his home.

Born Tuesday, July 3, 1956 in Brooklyn, New York, Mickey was the son of the late Jerry and Connie McFarland.

Mickey was raised in Coney Island, and was a graduate of Lafayette High School. He would start a long time career with the New York City Department of Transportation as a highway repairer. Mickey was former president of DC 37 Local 1157, of the New York City Department of Transportation employees. In 1995 Mickey settled in Old Bridge, to be closer to family.

Named after the great Mickey Mantle, it is no surprise that Mickey was a lifelong avid fan of the New York Yankees, a passion he passed onto his son, Mickey. Mickey also loved music namely bands like the Beatles and Cream, and was a drummer in a band. Some of Mickey's other passions were riding his Harley Davidsons and classic muscle cars, especially his Chevelle. He was also a strong supporter of the 45th President of the United States Donald J. Trump.

Mickey was predeceased by his parents Jerry and Connie, and by his brothers Joseph and Jerome Jr.

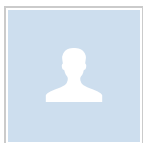
