October 10, 1930 - October 30, 2024

Paul Perez Buissereth, 94 of Englishtown, New Jersey passed away peacefully on Wednesday, October 30, 2024, at home.

Born Friday, October 10, 1930 in Fond Des Blancs, Haiti, Paul was the son of Emile Edouard and Cleoda Buissereth.

Paul was raised in Haiti where he met Marie Christiane Buissereth. The couple would marry in 1966 and start a family of their own. In 1977, Paul immigrated to the United States, living in Brooklyn. He would later be joined by his family in 1985, and they would raise their children in Brooklyn.

Paul was a hard worker, whether working as a welder in New York or completing jobs around the house. He was a devout Catholic, who was a member of Our Lady of Refuge Catholic Church. Paul enjoyed playing dominos and card games with friends, he had a love for music and dancing. He was a kind, loving and generous soul. Paul also enjoyed his many trips back to Haiti. More than anything Paul was a man of character and family man, who always cherished his time spent with his loved ones. He was the youngest of eleven siblings.
