Paul Vincent Marturano, 83 of Old Bridge, New Jersey passed away peacefully on Saturday, January 7, 2023, with his family by his side at the Jersey Shore Medical Center in Neptune, New Jersey.

Paul was born on Friday, August 18, 1939 in Bronx, New York. He was the son of the late Vincent and Mary Marturano, and grew up in Bayonne, NJ.

Paul was a graduate of Bayonne High School. After graduation, he worked for a year at a newspaper before joining the United States Army. Paul would complete his basic training at Fort Benning in Georgia, before being stationed in Monterey and Washington State. He returned to his hometown after earning his Honorable Discharge from the United States Army.

Paul would go to work in banking on Wall Street in New York City. It was there he would meet the love of his life Carol Matarazzo. The couple married in 1965 and moved to Jersey City. There they would start a family, before settling in Old Bridge in 1969. Paul would have a long career in sales, retiring from CPO Oil in Rahway as a Sales Manager.

Throughout the years Paul volunteered his time in the Old Bridge community. He was a coach at the Old Bridge Little League, and also served on the board. Paul enjoyed playing softball and played for many years in a local

softball league. In his spare time, Paul enjoyed reading, watching old Western movies and television shows and doing crossword puzzles. He loved history, and was fascinated with movies and stories about WWII. Paul was a big sports fan and enjoyed rooting for his three favorite teams, the NY Yankees and NY Giants and occasionally the NY Jets. Paul enjoyed sharing his love of the Yankees with his five grandsons, who brought him such pride and joy. What Paul loved the most was being surrounded by his family and he will be deeply missed by all those that loved him in return.
