Captain Paul F. Rocque passed away on Nov. 14, 2009. He was born March 13, 1926 in Whitehall, NY. An Alumni of Brown University, Capt. Rocque graduated from North Creek(NY) High School. He lived on Staten Island for 27 years before moving to Old Bridge in 1988. Captain Rocque served honorably in the US Navy for 43 years. He enjoyed his military service while serving on several destroyers and battleships, notably the USS Bordelon DDS 881. Throughout his Naval career, he was stationed in Korea, Japan, New Orleans, and the Brooklyn Naval Yard. While serving in the US Naval Reserve, Capt. Rocque worked for CitiBank for 20 years as an Asst. Vice President before retiring in 1988. In retirement, he enjoyed traveling the world, swimming at the YMCA, and watching his grandchildren grow up. Capt. Rocque was an officer in the Naval Reserve Association for many years. He was predeceased by his parents, Romuald "Romeo" and Sarah Rocque. Paul is survived by his daughters, Laurie Hobson and Bethany Rocque-Romaine, Esq.
