Richard W. Meyers, 75 of Old Bridge, New Jersey passed away on Thursday, January 27, 2022, at his home surrounded by his loving family.

Born Sunday, May 26, 1946 in Brooklyn, New York, he was the son of the late Solomon and Jean Meyers.

Richie, as he was known to his family and friends, was a graduate of Tilden High School. He also graduated with a Bachelor's Degree from Long Island University. Richie served his country honorably in the United States Army Reserve and earned his Honorable Discharge.
