Ronald Giordano, 80 of Old Bridge, New Jersey passed away on Thursday, April 10, 2025, at the Raritan Bay Medical Center in Old Bridge.

Born Monday, July 24, 1944 in Bronx, New York, Ronald was the son of the late Anthony and Carmela Giordano.

Ronald was raised in the Bronx before eventually moving to Brooklyn. After high school Ronald was drafted into the United States army during the Vietnam War, and after serving his country honorably he returned to live in Brooklyn.
