



Roylan Fernandez

August 8, 1992 - February 23, 2026

Roylan was born in La Vega, Dominican Republic, on August 8th, 1992. In January of 1993, his loving parents, Altagracia and Danilo Fernandez, made the move to New York City, where he would grow up as the eldest, quietly stepping into a role of responsibility long before most ever have to. From an early age, there was a steadiness to him, a calm, grounded presence that others naturally leaned on, even if he never asked for it.

He became the first in his family to graduate from college, earning a degree in Mechanical Engineering from SUNY Maritime. It was there that he met his best friend, Jerson, forming a bond built on mutual respect, shared ambition, and an unspoken understanding of what it meant to carry responsibility with quiet strength. After graduating, he began his career at BlackRock, where he dedicated over a decade of his life. He approached his work the same way he approached everything else, with discipline, consistency, and a sense of duty that did not need recognition to be real.

From a young age, Roylan had a natural affinity for working with his hands. He was drawn to anything mechanical or technical, finding both focus and purpose in understanding how things worked and how they could be improved. Whether it was rebuilding his BMW piece by piece or taking on one of his many projects at home, he worked with patience and precision. He did not rush, and he did not cut corners. For him, building was not just a hobby, it

was a reflection of how he moved through life: methodical, intentional, and quietly determined.

As the eldest sibling, he carried himself as more than just a brother. He became a second father figure to his younger brother and sister, Rogelin and Natacha, offering guidance, protection, and stability without ever needing to announce it. He showed up for them in ways that were steady and dependable, creating a sense of security that only someone with his strength of character could provide. He did not speak often about sacrifice, but he lived it every day.

Roylan had a way of connecting with people that felt natural and genuine. He could become friends with almost anyone, often through shared interests or simple conversation, but what set him apart was not just his ability to connect, it was his willingness to help. He gave his time, his knowledge, and his effort without hesitation, expecting nothing in return. There was a quiet generosity in him, one that came from a place of principle rather than obligation.

What made Roylan truly remarkable was not just what he accomplished, but how he carried himself through it all. He did not seek attention or praise. He did not complain when things became difficult. He simply endured, adapted, and continued forward. There was a stoic strength in him, a quiet resilience that allowed him to bear the weight of responsibility while still being present for the people he loved. He was steady when things were uncertain, strong when things were heavy, and dependable when it mattered most.

Roylan lived with integrity, with purpose, and with a kind of quiet courage that left a lasting impression on everyone who had the privilege of knowing him. Most of all his parents, who were always proud of him for all his achievements, talent, and wisdom and always have, and always will, love him.

En enero de 1993, su madre y padre, Altagracia y Danilo Fernandez, se trasladó a la ciudad de Nueva York, donde creció como el mayor, asumiendo silenciosamente una responsabilidad mucho antes de lo que a la mayoría le toca. Desde muy joven, había en él una estabilidad notable, una presencia tranquila y firme en la que otros podían apoyarse, incluso sin que él lo buscara. Fue el primero en su familia en graduarse de la universidad, obteniendo un título en Ingeniería Mecánica de SUNY Maritime. Allí conoció a su mejor amigo, Jerson, formando un vínculo basado en respeto mutuo, ambición compartida y una comprensión silenciosa de lo que significa cargar responsabilidades con fortaleza interior. Después de graduarse, comenzó su carrera en BlackRock, donde dedicó más de una década de su vida. En su trabajo, al igual que en todo lo demás, actuaba con disciplina, constancia y un sentido del deber que no necesitaba reconocimiento para ser real.

Desde pequeño, Roylan tenía una afinidad natural por trabajar con sus manos. Le atraía todo lo mecánico y técnico, encontrando propósito en entender cómo funcionaban las cosas y cómo mejorarlas. Ya fuera reconstruyendo su BMW pieza por pieza o

trabajando en
alguno de sus muchos proyectos en casa, lo hacía con paciencia y precisión.
No se
apresuraba ni tomaba atajos. Para él, construir no era solo un pasatiempo,
era un reflejo de
su manera de vivir: metódica, intencional y silenciosamente determinada.
Como hermano mayor, fue más que un simple hermano. Se convirtió en una
figura paterna
para su hermano y su hermana menores, Rogelin y Natacha, brindándoles
guía, protección y
estabilidad sin necesidad de decirlo. Siempre estuvo presente de una manera
firme y
confiable, creando una sensación de seguridad que solo alguien con su
carácter podía
ofrecer. No hablaba de sacrificios, pero los vivía todos los días.

Roylan tenía una forma natural y genuina de conectar con las personas.
Podía hacerse
amigo de casi cualquiera, muchas veces a través de intereses compartidos o
conversaciones
sencillas. Pero lo que realmente lo distinguía no era solo su capacidad de
conectar, sino su
disposición a ayudar. Ofrecía su tiempo, su conocimiento y su esfuerzo sin
dudarlo, sin
esperar nada a cambio. Había en él una generosidad silenciosa que nacía de
sus principios.
Lo que hacía a Roylan verdaderamente especial no era solo lo que logró, sino
cómo se
comportó a lo largo de su vida. No buscaba atención ni reconocimiento. No se
quejaba ante
la dificultad. Simplemente resistía, se adaptaba y seguía adelante. Había en

él una fortaleza

estoica, una resiliencia tranquila que le permitía cargar con responsabilidades mientras

seguía estando presente para quienes amaba. Fue firme en la incertidumbre, fuerte en los momentos difíciles y confiable cuando más importaba.

Roylan vivió con integridad, con propósito y con un tipo de valentía silenciosa que dejó una huella duradera en todos los que tuvieron el privilegio de conocerlo. Sobre todo sus padres, que siempre estuvieron orgullosos de él por todos sus logros, talento y sabiduría y siempre lo han amado y siempre lo amarán.

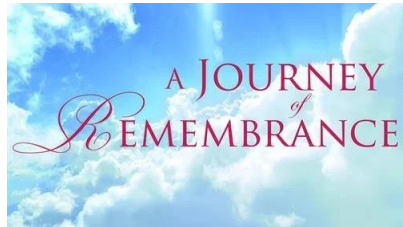
