



## Rudolph Perez

September 25, 1936 - January 5, 2020

Rudolph Perez, age 83 of Parlin, New Jersey, passed away on Sunday, January 5, 2020, at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital in New Brunswick, New Jersey surrounded by his family.

He was born Friday, September 25, 1936, in New York, New York to Lino and Aurelia Perez, and was the oldest of three children. Rudolph was raised in Brooklyn, New York. 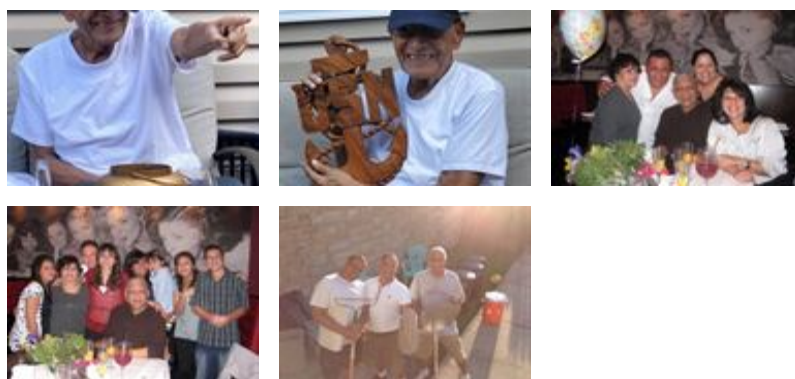
