Salvatore Candilora, 100 of Tinton Falls, New Jersey passed away on Tuesday, March 18, 2025.

Born Friday, August 1, 1924 in Brooklyn, New York, Salvatore was the son of the late Barney and Mary Candilora.

Salvatore was raised in the Prospect Park neighborhood of Brooklyn. After graduating from High School, Salvatore enlisted in the United States Army, serving his country honorably during World War II.
