Scott Wigandt, 56 of Howell, New Jersey passed away on Saturday, November 18, 2023, at home, surrounded by the love of his family.

Born Tuesday, March 28, 1967 in Staten Island, New York, Scott was the son of the late Donald and Lorraine Wigandt.

Scott was raised on Staten Island, and was a graduate of Monsignor Farrell High School. He would meet the love of his life, Anesha Tukailo, and the couple would marry. Scott would serve his country honorably in the United States Navy. He was a submariner who was stationed in Groton, CT as well as Scotland, after he graduated from Submariner school in San Diego. After receiving an Honorable Discharge and returning home to Staten Island, Scott and Anesha would start a family of their own.

The couple would reside on Staten Island until 2005 when they settled in Howell, NJ. Scott worked in Howell as a letter carrier for the United States Postal Service.

Scott was a big fan of comics and sci-fi movies, he loved going to comic con with his lifelong friends Mario and Sandy Merlino. He enjoyed Star Wars and was a huge R2 D2 fan and loved talking about movies with his dear friend Michael Tobin. He had a special bond with Kathleen Ducey where they shared

long conversations about the little rascals and Seinfeld. Scott also was extremely creative and enjoyed spending time working on his art. He loved listening to good music, especially the Beatles. He loved being with his family the most, and he will be missed by all those that were blessed to have him in their lives.

Scott is survived by his beloved wife of 32 years, Anesha, by his loving children, Hannah Furnell and her husband Craig, and Connor Wigandt, and by his caring siblings, John Wigandt, Kathleen Witteck, Dianne Stecher, and Eileen Wassman.

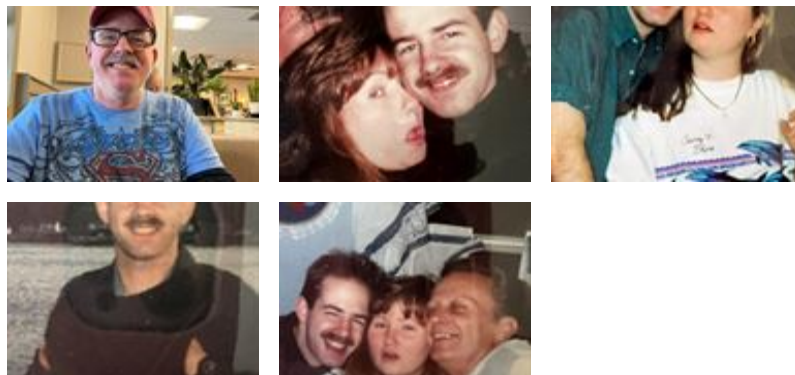
