Thomas Kelly, 95, of Holmdel and formerly of Middletown and of Old Bridge, passed away quietly on Monday morning at Bayshore Health Care Center, Holmdel. He was an engineer with the New York City Transit Authority for 28 years, retiring in 1977. He was a communicant of St Ambrose RC Church in Old Bridge for years and was an avid NY Yankees fan. Thomas was always a family man. Born in Manhattan, he was raised there and lived in the Bronx for many years before moving to Old Bridge where he lived for 25 years relocating to Middletown in 2003 and more recently to Holmdel.
