If Thomas was not at home or on the golf course, chances were that he could be found with his wife in Atlantic City at a poker bar or in the "Diamond Club" enjoying dinner and a drink, where not a moment would have passed without a smile being on his face. Thomas was a loving and caring man who will be missed dearly by all those that were blessed to have him in their lives.
