



Thomas Risholdt

December 13, 1944 - January 15, 2024

Thomas Risholdt, 79 of Old Bridge, New Jersey passed away on Monday, January 15, 2024, at the Raritan Bay Medical Center in Old Bridge, New Jersey.

Born Wednesday, December 13, 1944 in Jersey City, Thomas was the son of the late Thomas and Thelma Risholdt.

Thomas was raised in Jersey City and was a graduate of Snyder High School. After High School Thomas joined the United States Army, serving in the 1st Calvary Division. After completing basic training he was deployed to South Korea and guarded the 38th parallel. Later he would say his outdoor patrols during the winter were the coldest he has ever felt. After his tour he received a honorable discharge and later served an additional 16 years in the army reserve. Whenever he saw a fellow veteran he always took the time to stop to talk about their service and to thank them.

After his military service, Thomas joined his father in the construction trade, working for 12 years in the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners. Following his years in construction, Thomas worked in security for the Institute for Defense Analysis in Princeton before his retirement 17 years ago. In both the military and civilian work he was known for his dedication and an uncompromising work ethic.

Thomas would meet the love of his life, Irene Zub, and the couple would marry in 1973. They would first live in the Vailsburg section of Newark, before moving to Old Bridge in 1977. There they started a family of their own and raised their two sons.

Thomas loved antique cars all his life and enjoyed visiting the local car shows. He also enjoyed going on cruises and visiting casinos in Atlantic City and Las Vegas, and also loved watching football on television and attending minor league baseball games.

Thomas is survived by his beloved wife of 50 years, Irene, by his loving sons, Michael and Mark, and by his cherished granddaughter Charlotte.

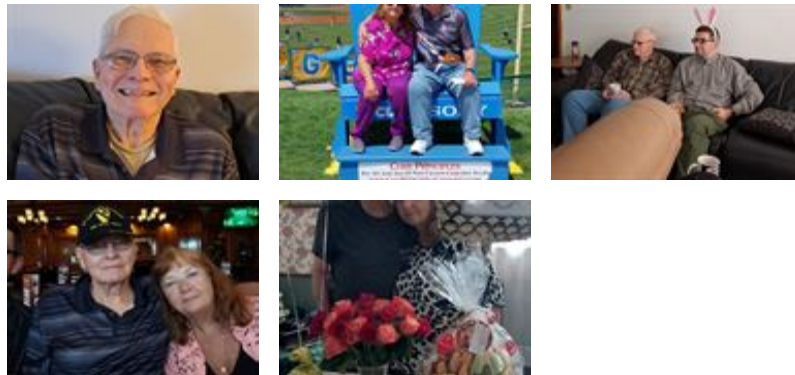
