Warren Henry Habel, 92, of the Bronx, NY died Monday, March 23, 2015 at Summerhill Nursing Home in Old Bridge, NJ. He was born in the Bronx, NY on November 7, 1922 to the late Henry and Alice (Hardy) Habel where he remained a lifetime resident. He was a proud United States Navy veteran of WWII and recipient of the European Theater Ribbon, Asiatic Pacific Theatre Ribbon, Good Conduct Medal, Philippine Liberation Ribbon and American Theatre Ribbon.
