Former Randall Manor resident William J. Lorusso, 89, of Manalapan, N.J., a retired banker, died Tuesday in The Manor, in Freehold, N.J. Born in the Bronx, he moved to Randall Manor in 1976. He lived there until 1983, when he relocated to Deland, Fla. Two years ago, he took up residence in Manalapan. During World War II, Mr. Lorusso served in the U.S. Navy, and saw duty in France. After the war, he began his 30-year career as a banker with JP Morgan on Wall Street. He retired in 1980. In Florida, Mr. Lorusso was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, American Legion and Knights of Columbus. He also belonged to Florida chapters of the Elks Lodge and Moose Lodge. He loved to socialize, enjoyed the singing of Frank Sinatra and was known among his family and friends as the life of the party. He liked baseball, especially the New York Yankees. His favorite food was pasta and his favorite "Peanuts" character was Snoopy. "Above everything else," said his daughter, Anna Moramarco, "he enjoyed spending time with his family." Also surviving are his wife of 62 years, the former Jennie Dantuono, and two granddaughters. Arrangements, including cremation, are being handled by the Michael Hegarty Funeral Home, Old Bridge, N.J. Burial of ashes will take place in Brig. Gen. William C. Doyle Veterans Memorial Cemetery, Arneytown, N.J.
