Yohama De Los Angeles Alvarez, 94, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by family on Wednesday, January 26, 2022.

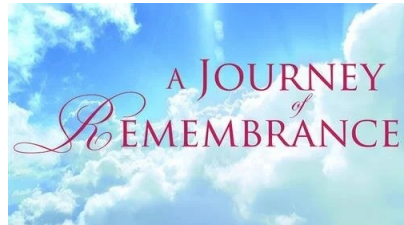

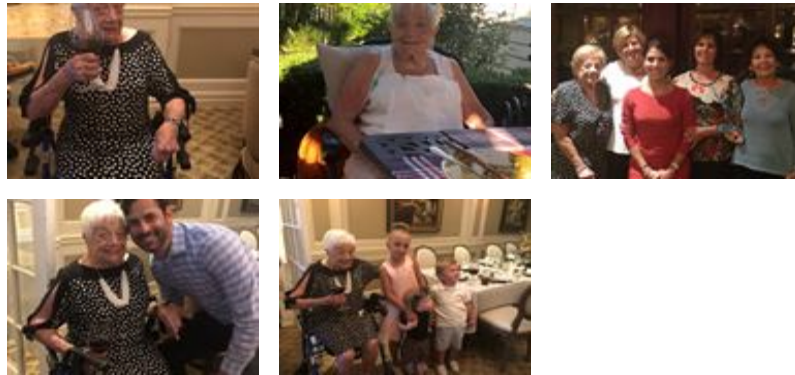
